Let the Top Twenty ranked Silky Terriers '*enchant*' you in this exclusive Showcase. Judged and evaluated under three distinct judges including, an AKC Judge, a Breeder Judge, and a Handler Judge. This event allows you to view the top winning Silkys from all over the United States as they are evaluated for conformation, movement, and showmanship.

You will never get the chance to see all of these fine Silkys in one ring at the same time outside of this prestigious event.

Silkys and their owners will be notified by official invitation and are required to enter in advance. There will be a separate catalog for this event.

This event is by *Invitation Only* for the Top Twenty Silkys ranked in both Breed and All-Breed points. The Silkys are judged by each of the three Judges using a score sheet with points allotted to various categories representing key points from the Silky Standard. The points are then tabulated and averaged to determine winners.

The Silky Terrier earning the highest number of points is awarded the title of the Top Silky Terrier at the Showcase. There will also be an award for the Silky Terrier which is owned and handled by the Breeder – the Top Bred-by-Exhibitor Silky Terrier at the Showcase. In some cases the winner will be one and the same.

This is a highly honored event; you are encouraged to dress for the occasion and enjoy a truly '*enchanting evening*'. This year the event will feature a cash bar for cocktails and a plated dinner prior to the event. Each attendee will have the chance to win fabulous door prizes during the showcase as well as receive a Top Twenty Catalog and special gift commemorating the evening. There is a Best in Sweepstakes and a Best of Opposite to Best in Sweepstakes awarded along with first through fourth placements for each class. No championship points are awarded for this competition.

Veteran Sweepstakes classifications include dogs and bitches at least 7 years of age and under 9 years of age, 9 years of age and under 11 years of age, and 11 years of age and older. There is a Best in Sweeps and a Best of Opposite to Best in Sweeps awarded along with first through fourth placements for each class. No championship points are awarded for this competition.

### Parade of Rescue and Companion Dogs

This Parade is a celebration of our Rescue and Companion dogs and the people who love them. Dogs may be presented in full show coats or household clips.

### Parade of Seniors

This parade is a celebration of our veteran dogs. Silky's 10 years of age or older or who will be 10 years old before the end of 2007 are eligible for this non-competitive event. Dogs with or without titles may enter. Seniors may be presented in full show coat or senior clips.



## Canine Good Citizen

Canine Good Citizen (CGC) is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club. For those Silky's successfully completing the CGC at the Specialty, there will be special recognition at the Annual Awards Dinner. ## Obedience

### Sit! Stay! Down!

The Obedience Trial is designed to test your Silkys ability to perform a prescribed set of exercises on which it is scored. There are (3) three levels at which your dog can earn a title and each is more difficult than the one before it. This is truly a performance event. The best part is watching the close bond between the dog and the handler.

Obedience winners will also be honored at the Annual Awards Dinner Friday evening May 11, 2007. Entries for Obedience close April 18, 2007. Consult the official premium list for all classes offered. ## Agility

Agility is a performance event for our Silkys in which their handler directs them through an obstacle course in an accurate race against the clock. Silkys must run off-leash with no food or toys as incentives.

Consequently, the handler's only controls are voice and body language, requiring exceptional obedience training of the dog. In competition, the handler must assess the course, decide on handling strategies and direct the dog through the course, with precision and speed equally important.



Please plan to attend this event showcasing the versatility and athleticism of our breed. Hoffman Park is approximately two miles from the host hotel and has been a successful venue for many dog events in Albuquerque.

# About Albuquerque

## The Heart of New Mexico

Albuquerque, a Mecca of urban sophistication, is easy to get to. Direct and non-stop flights on major airlines serve Albuquerque daily. The city is also a destination for transcontinental Amtrak trains.

Interstates 25 and 40 are Albuquerque's major thoroughfares, intersecting in the middle of the city. Traffic delays are infrequent, and the average inner-city drive is 15 minutes or less. Legendary Route 66 can still be traveled today—it is now Central Avenue, Albuquerque's "Main Street."



Though Albuquerque is high desert with the altitude about a mile high (5200 feet above sea level). The majestic Sandia mountains rise more than 10,000 feet above the city. If you are from sea level, please keep that in mind - most every one feels tired until they adjust, and that feeling is intensified with physical activity. Albuquerque also has very low humidity, so drink plenty of water.
